- show care and concern for the needs and well-being of their students;
- display dedication and commitment to the pursuit of excellence in the teaching and learning of the Malay Language in the classroom and beyond.

Most Inspiring Tamil Teachers' Award (MITT) 2025

The Most Inspiring Tamil Teacher Award is an annual award presented by Tamil Murasu, the Tamil Language Learning and Promotion Committee, and the Singapore Tamil Teachers' Union.

This award recognises Tamil Language teachers who:

- have made significant contributions to the teaching and learning of the language;
- nurture students' interest in Tamil Language by using innovative methods to make lessons more interesting and engaging; and

 demonstrate a keen interest in students' well-being and inspire students to be self-directed and engaged learners.
